### Daily Challenges

Choose one or more to do this week.

- Look up the Old Testament promises concerning Jesus in Isaiah 7:14; Micah 5:2; Psalm 72:10; Isaiah 40:3; Malachi 3:1; Zechariah 9:9; Psalm 16:10; Psalm 41:9; Zechariah 11:12; Zechariah 13:7; Psalm 35:11; Psalm 22:16; Isaiah 53:12; Psalm 69:4; Psalm 22:18; Psalm 69:21; Psalm 34:20; Zechariah 12:10; Amos 8:9; and Isaiah 53:9. See if you can find the fulfillment of each promise in the Gospels and thank God for keeping His promises by sending Jesus.
- Sing at least one Christmas carol a day to celebrate the gift of God's son.
- Look for evidence of God with you this week. Thank Jesus for fulfilling God's promise and being His presence here on earth.

### Further Study and Discussion throughout the week

Use the following passages and questions to explore additional Biblical insights about your heart.

Each day this week, look up the promise in the listed passage and think about what each promise means to you right now and why you do or don't believe God is keeping it for you.
