Choose one or more to do this week.

Use the following passages and questions to explore additional Biblical insights about your heart.

Monday—Psalm 119:148

What promises from God's Word can you meditate on? Why is it helpful to continually think about them?

Tuesday—Joshua 21:43-45

What in your life shows that you trust God to keep His promises?

Wednesday—Psalm 119:137-140

God's promises have been tested. What does this mean to you? How have you seen God's promises proven true in your own life?

Thursday—Psalm 145:13

How are God's love and his faithfulness connected? What does the word all in this verse signify to you?

Friday—2 Corinthians 1:18-20

What does it mean that God's promises are "yes" and "amen" through Jesus? What does Jesus' life and death on earth show you about God's faithfulness?

Saturday—Matthew 5:33-37
