Monday—1 Peter 1:3

Tuesday—John 11:25

What scares you about death? What gives you hope about the promise of eternal life?

Wednesday—1 Corinthians 15:54-57

Why is it significant that Jesus had victory over death? What things in your life feel like "death"? How can you let Jesus have the victory in those areas?

Thursday—Ephesians 2:6

What are some benefits you've felt or experienced because we're alive with Jesus?

Friday—Romans 8:11

What does it really look like for your mortal body to have life through the Spirit?

Saturday—Romans 6:9-10

How confident are you that your salvation through Jesus is firm, once and for all? Explain.

Talk Topics

Think about the closest person to you who has died. How did that affect you?

When Jesus died, what happened? How do you know for sure?

Talk about the time you first began to understand the true meaning of Easter.

Discuss ways you can realistically face the pain of death and joyfully celebrate the truth of resurrection.
