We encounter our risen Lord Jesus as He reveals Himself to us in His word and meal.

Reflection Questions for This Week

When have I been overwhelmed by events that have shattered my expectations? How did Jesus come alongside me in these circumstances to guide and enlighten me?

In what ways have I taken for granted the Word and Meal worship gathering? Why is an encounter with the risen Jesus in His Word and Supper essential to following Him?

The two disciples' hearts burned, their feet ran, and their mouths opened because of their encounter with the risen King Jesus. How does Jesus' resurrection propel me into missional living in daily life?
