## **Preschool Summer Camp Volunteer Job Descriptions**

**Bible Adventure Leader:** This leader helps bring the Bible stories to life through interactive and engaging experiences.

**Craft and Play Leader:** This patient and creative leader manages materials and guides the kids in creating crafts.

**Craft and Play Assistant:** This assistant aids the preschool Craft and Play leader in preparing materials and guiding them through a variety of crafts.

**Crew Leader:** Have fun going station to station with the preschoolers. Two crew leaders lead a group of kids through their assigned schedule. There's no preparation required. A crew leader is a friend, and helper for the kids and for the station leaders.

**Exploration Station Leader:** The Exploration Station leader encourages creativity and brings the Bible point to life through a variety of interactive activity centers.

**Exploration Station Assistant:** This assistant helps the Exploration Station leader in preparing daily materials and helps engage the kids in a variety of activities.

**Games Leader:** This energetic and organized individual is in charge of leading groups of kids in fun activities.

**Games Assistant:** A game assistant helps the games leader in preparing and leading fun activities.

**Music Leader:** This leader sings Pets Unleashed and Bible songs with the kids.

**Opening/Closing Leader:** This energetic leader can create and control excitement. They will sing, act, teach, and lead an engaging and interactive experience for kids.

**Snack Leader:** This organized individual is in charge of preparing materials and guiding the process of serving a snack.

**Snack Assistant:** The snack assistant aids the snack leader in organizing materials and any prep work required for preparing and delivering the snacks.

**Administrative Team:** Organized individuals who assist the Camp Director with daily tasks to make camp run smoothly.

**Art/Decor Team:** Assist the Camp Director with preparation and execution of decorations in months leading up to camp.

**Clean Up Crew:** Assist with clean up after the event by putting away items in storage and hauling away trash.

**Floater:** Willing to fill in wherever there's a need. You may fill in as a crew leader, assist at a station, complete prep work, clean, etc. This is a huge way to help especially if you want to help and only can come a couple days.

**Prep Team:** Assist the Camp Director with sorting and prepping items needed for camp. (ie. sorting craft items, t-shirts, labeling items)

**Welcome/Greeter Team:** This individual makes everyone who enters feel at home and is able to communicate, direct, and answer questions.
